February 8, 2005 - The LPIA will host its' first meeting on February 8, 2005 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Edgemere Senior Center. This meeting is **VERY** important as we have many issues to discuss. Below is a brief summary of the issues to be discussed. (Please note, if the meeting is canceled due to snow, the meeting will be held on February 15, 2005.)

a) **Donations**: Donations were down in 2004. And while the LPIA understands that there is a lot of construction and maintenance going on due to Hurricane Isabel, the costs associated with maintaining the ball field and playground have not gone down, and in fact have increased. The LPIA will begin its annual donation drive in February. Help distributing letters is always appreciated.

b) **Ball field Lease** – The LPIA has been approached by the Baltimore County Recreation Council about leasing our ball field on Grace Road. If we lease the ball field to Baltimore County, they may take over all costs associated with maintaining the property. However, Baltimore County would then have control of the field and will use it as they see fit. In that event, if LPIA wants to use the field for an organized event we would have to get a permit from Baltimore County. The LPIA Officers need to discuss this with the Community at the February 8th meeting because donations are down and it is getting harder and harder to pay our expenses.

c) **Fundraisers** – The LPIA has sent a donation letter to all businesses that operate in the Lynch Point area. We will provide an update at the meeting. The LPIA would like to host a bull roast sometime in the Spring and we need help. Dates and ideas will be discussed at the meeting.

d) **Open Forum** – As always, the LPIA will dedicate some time at the end of the meeting to discuss any other issues.
